

EICS: Scheduled Maintenance, 28-30 August

DFAIT will be undertaking maintenance and upgrades to their electrical and backup power systems on August 28-30, 2009. The work will commence on Friday, August 28 at 21:00 (EDT) and run until Monday, August 31 at 04:00 (EDT).

During this period, there is minimal risk with respect to the scheduled publication of the EICB reports including the daily softwood lumber reports. Although DFAIT is making every effort to ensure that there is no impact on reporting, it continues to be the responsibility of all softwood lumber companies to manage their exports in accordance with established monthly levels.
